Step 2

With the book's **ISBN** at hand, login to *ScienceDirect* using the [Off-Campus Access](#) portal. For those who may need assistance please follow the annotations in the graphical guide below.

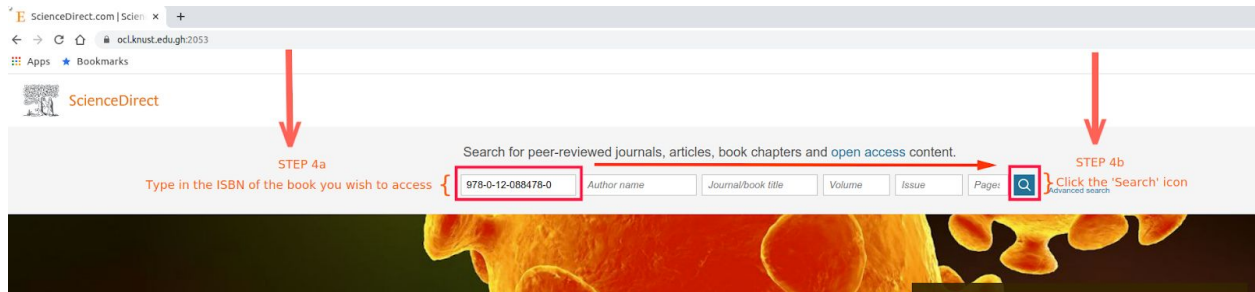

You will be redirected to another page.

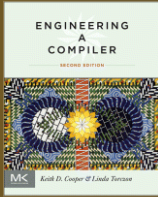
